Kuju Flower Park spreads out over 220,000 square meters in Kuju Highland which is located in the center of Kyushu. A total of 5 million flowers of about 500 different species bloom from spring to autumn. Within the park you can experience different and unthinkable beautiful scenery in the Forest Area, Flower Field Area, Wildflowers Area and more!
